

We specialize in serving individuals with profound disabilities and highly specialized medical needs providing onsite 24-hour nursing care when necessary. We provide support that values the competence, strengths, and desires of each individual. Each person served is encouraged and empowered to develop the skills and capabilities needed to increase self-reliance and enhance quality of life.

THE CAUSE

The Eat Well - Live Well (EWLW) Initiative at HBI

Research has shown that what we eat and the lifestyle choices we make can be like medicine for the human body and human spirit. The Eat Well-Live Well (EWLW) Initiative at HBI is taking what we know to be true and implementing changes in our programming to move that knowledge into action.

HBI is actively analyzing the nutrient quality of our menus. Under the guidance of our Director of Nursing and key outside partners HBI will implement and standardize new and improved healthy menus across our 22 locations.

HBI is evaluating the individualized needs of all residents and eliminating all canned and pre-packaged meals from our homes. Standardized menus and shopping lists will aim to keep meals healthy for those we serve.

HBI is also moving to a new family-style dining approach at all of our homes while also inviting staff to eat with the individuals they serve.

Rewritten menus will include meal plans suitable for diabetes, high blood pressure, immobility, weight challenges, and metabolism challenges. HBI will interactively train staff on how to prepare meals so they feel confident and capable of delivering this service to our residents.

We are also incorporating seasonal menus that include both cultural and family traditional recipes. We are inviting staff and families to submit their favorite recipes to be included in the optional menu rotation and ultimately in the future, an HBI Cookbook.
