GREETINGS FROM THE CEO

What a Wonderful Adventure

In 2025, the Homeward Bound team made contributions to the lives of our residents that cannot be overstated. The moments we witness each day are truly priceless and continue to move our mission forward. Staff dedicate countless hours and tremendous energy to delivering person-centered care and active support, ensuring that each individual we serve is not only cared for, but meaningfully engaged in their own life journey.

Volunteer engagement reached new heights in 2025, and our plans for 2026 are even more ambitious. From student volunteers participating in crafts, sharing laughter, and making connections into our homes, to corporate partners building curbside tiny libraries and helping cultivate our one-of-a-kind accessible garden, these efforts have enriched daily life across our HBI community. Each home participates in the garden experience growing shared moments with one another.

Before the close of 2025, HBI launched its first-ever resident bowling club and celebrated with a kickoff event at Park Tavern Bowl in St. Louis Park. The turnout of residents, staff, and supporters at the launch event was a powerful reminder of how with a little creativity and hardwork community activities can be accessible to all regardless of your abilities.

In Spring 2026, HBI launched a dedicated fund to support our new Adventure Club. This initiative grew directly out of our commitment to individualized annual recreation planning, introduced for every resident in 2025. Through key partnerships, residents now have opportunities to explore beyond their immediate community whether traveling by bus and plane or setting sail to destinations like Ely, Minnesota, and beyond. The Adventure Club turns plans into action, offering both routine and special experiences, including an upcoming all-agency day at the zoo this coming summer.

Our annual Golf + Gala enters its 30th anniversary year later in 2026 with an expanded format. New elements include dinner-only ticket options, a special Fund-A-Need campaign, and powerful storytelling that highlights HBI's mission in action. This year's event will take place on August 24, 2026. Advocacy also remained a priority this past year. During this year's legislative day at the capitol in March 2026,



HBI team members and residents participated in 15 one-on-one meetings with lawmakers at the capitol, championing policies and funding that strengthen disability services.

We also proudly recognized the first graduates of HBI's Leadership Academy in Spring 2026. This program prepares staff for growth and advancement while they continue in their current roles, strengthening leadership at every level of the organization. The Academy's annual conference, held on February 20, 2026, featured a keynote address by renowned adventurer and polar explorer Will Steger, reinforcing our spirit of exploration and resilience.

HBI staff took to adventures sharing their expertise with the broader disability services field by presenting seven different conference workshops in 2025 and in 2026 we are already being welcomed to do more. By sharing best practices and learning from peers, we foster innovation and build a culture of continuous quality improvement.

As we look ahead, your support is more important than ever. About Homeward Bound

Homeward Bound began in 1973 when a group of parents recognized that their children with disabilities deserved more than institutional care, they deserved the ability to participate fully in their communities. What started as a grassroots effort grew into a nonprofit organization dedicated to helping children, adolescents, and adults with disabilities find their voice, exercise choice, and live dignified lives.

Today, Homeward Bound provides person-centered residential services in 22 community-based neighborhood homes in the Twin Cities metro area. Our philosophy is simple: every individual should have the opportunity to make decisions about their own life, build meaningful relationships, develop skills, and be an active member of their community.

All our homes provide 24-hour support by staff who provide active support to individuals focused on independence, personal growth, and community engagement. Innovative programming is provided to help residents live lives of joy and fulfillment including through life-enriching recreational and social activities.

Mid-Medical Homes offer all the benefits of traditional residential services while supporting individuals with a variety of health needs. Direct Support Professionals are trained to assist with feeding tubes, seizure management, specialized

diets, transfers, skin monitoring, and other medical supports. Nurse case management oversight and electronic health records help ensure well-coordinated, individualized care.

High Medical Homes provide the highest level of residential support, combining community living with around-the-clock nursing care. These homes are equipped to support individuals with ventilators, tracheostomies, CPAP and BiPAP therapies, wound care needs, catheter management, and other complex medical conditions. Licensed nurses work alongside Direct Support Professionals to deliver hospital-level care within a residential setting.

Placement in any of our twenty 245D licensed setting is funded through the following waivers: CAD1, DD, CAC, BI. Placement in one of our two Intermediate Care Facility (ICF) settings is funded through Medicaid.

More than fifty years after its founding, Homeward Bound continues to fulfill the vision of the families who created it: ensuring that people with disabilities have safe homes, quality care, meaningful opportunities, and the support needed to live full and self-directed lives.

At Homeward Bound, resident engagement goes beyond just providing round-the-clock care. We create opportunities for people to live their lives to the fullest, experience joy, adventure, connection, and personal growth. Through initiatives like **Recreation Reboot and Adventure Club** with activities that range from gardening to bowling and seasonal celebrations and travel residents are encouraged to explore new interests, build friendships, and participate in meaningful experiences throughout the community building confidence and advancing their independence.

A key part of Homeward Bound's mission is creating opportunities for residents to build connections, pursue interests, and engage with their communities. Through volunteer involvement individuals are supported in participating in activities that promote social interaction, personal growth, recreation, and community inclusion.

Volunteers play an important role in enriching the lives of residents by sharing their time, talents, and companionship. Whether assisting with group activities, participating in special events, supporting recreational





outings, or helping residents explore hobbies and interests, volunteers help create meaningful experiences and lasting relationships.

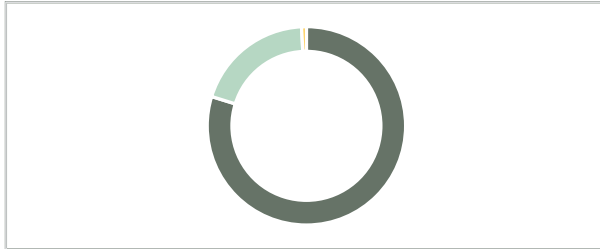

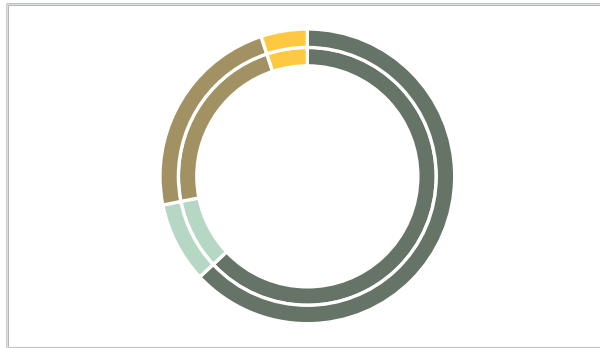

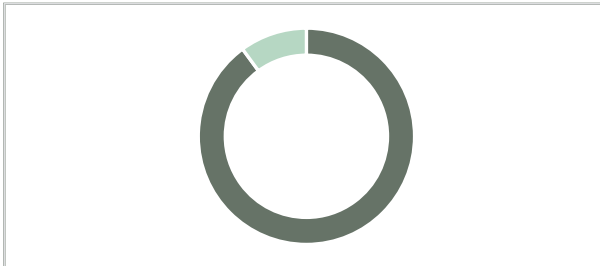
Total Agency Revenue

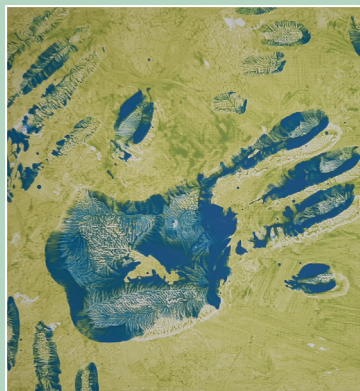
